Some of UCSC's undergraduate grading policies were permanently changed for the 2019-2020 academic year, and several temporary changes were made to respond to the graduate student grading strike and the move to remote instruction due to COVID-19. This chart indicates the quarters for which each policy change is effective, and includes the policy source document which provides more detailed information.
