Spend a few minutes Sunday or Monday talking with your student about our lesson. Here are some optional topics:

- Share something about friends you had when you were a teen. Were you a good friend or not so good? Ask who their best friends are right now - or if you think they don't have friends right now, ask what they would look for in a friend and brainstorm some ideas on how to get to know some new people.
- Ask your kid how you can pray for them. Share some things you have prayed
