·Celebrations/Highlights

1. Remote Learning Percentages (87% daily attendance)
 - a. Attendance is pulled each day by Jeanie and our ESP's take this time to go through the list and call the families of the student that did not log in that day to check to see if there is any support that is needed.
 - b. All of the admin have been getting onto some of the teacher Google meets to observe how the classes have been functioning online. It has been positive to see how students are virtually interacting. This experience has been going much better than anticipated.
2. Update on Nov 24th
