## **Project: Logo Design**

**Objective:** Design a <u>logo</u> based on a movie, book, sports team, musical singer or group.

## **Visual Requirements:**

- It must include at least two different kinds of triangles (you can have more).
- It must include at least two of the following: a translation, a rotation, reflection, or a dilation.
- The logo must be unique and *not* an alteration of another logo.

## **Written Requirements:**

- A description of the logo and *why it is a good representation* of the (book, team, movie, etc.)
- A detailed mathematical description of what geometric (ex: rotation, bisectors, isosceles triangle etc) features your logo contains.
- A mathematical description of *how you made the design*. What mathematical processes did you use to create the design?
