



Design Brief: Brockley Max Lewisham Mural Project

Location: Three shutters on Loampit Vale, Lewisham

Brockley Max is looking to commission talented muralists to spray paint vibrant and creative artwork on three shutters in Lewisham. The aim is to enhance the local environment and decorate a soon-to-be-developed stretch on the approach to Lewisham town centre.

This represents a superb chance to share your art with thousands of Lewisham residents every day. The site is temporary but expected to last a few years.

We want artwork that celebrates local musicians, sports figures, and famous local folks, and the importance of the environment. There's considerable freedom to celebrate your artistic expression and contribute to this vibrant area.

Location: Morley's: (3x4m), Carpet Direct (3x10m), Classique (3x4m) approx

What you need to do:

- Submit a concept proposal
- Complete the mural within the agreed time
- Provide a brief statement about your work and inspiration

This is a paid commission which Brockley Max (organised by CIC Max Media Arts) is facilitating on behalf of the Loampit Vale site's development partners, Amro, in return for their sponsorship of this year's community arts festival: www.brockleymax.co.uk.

Budget: £450 for Morleys and Classique, plus £80 for materials; £550 for Carpet Direct site and £160 for materials.

We encourage submissions that showcase a wide range of murals and art styles, and a diverse range of characters that reflect our local community.

Pitch Submission Deadline: 24 April

Project Completion Deadline: 14 May

Brockley Max (run by CIC Max Media Arts) has been tasked with commissioning mural artwork for the shutters of three disused shopfronts on Loampit Vale: Carpet Direct, Morley's Chicken and Classique Nail Bar. The work is on behalf of Amro Partners, which owns the site along with adjacent properties and will be redeveloping it. Submissions for murals on this site are accepted subject to your acceptance that this is a temporary site and the shutters featuring the murals will be removed once work onsite begins. The shutters and artwork will be owned by Amro Partners.
