The International Dyslexia Association, Los Angeles (IDALA) Grant Program seeks to award grants up to \$7,500 per school year (for up to two years per project) in order to support schools and/or school districts in implementing programs that meet the organization's priorities:

- **Priority 1:** Promote the sustainable use of effective academic and/or intervention programs that align with the [IDA's Knowledge and Practice Standards](#).
- **Priority 2:** Raise awareness and understanding of dyslexia in all settings (school, home, clinical, community) in order to support individuals with dyslexia, their families, and professionals.

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Completion of all sections
- Alignment of application with IDALA priorities 1 and/or 2
- Potential for impact at the school or district level
- Demonstration of high potential for impact based on financial need
- Capacity for scaling to sustainability without additional funding
