

Preprimary Sample Schedule

- 8:15am- The Preprimary levels begin their day on the playground, allowing for important social interactions, as well as time to release energy before the workday begins.
- 9:00am- The children then come into their classrooms, have a short community meeting, and begin individual work time. During this time, children are practicing new skills and having individual lessons.



- 11:30am- At the conclusion of their work time, the children have a second meeting with a story or short lesson before dismissing to carline, child care, or swimming.
- **11:45am** The afternoon is reserved for the kindergarten children only. They will start with transition and move to lunch when the preschoolers dismiss for the day.
- 12:00pm- The kindergarten children will go to the playground for their recess after lunch. On days when weather is not permitting, they will use the gym for recess time. Children will go outside unless it is raining or the wind chill is below 27 degrees.
- 12:30pm- The children will return to the classrooms to finish their afternoon. This
 time allows the teachers to have more one-on-one time with the older children for
 more academic work. The children have individual and small group lessons
 throughout the afternoon.
- Specials- Each class attends gym and music for a portion of their morning one day a week. All children also participate in swimming and the extended-day children take Spanish and religion classes. Swimming will take place after school hours (11:45am-12:30pm) for the preschool children, and during the regular school hours for the extended-day children.
