	Shot	First flight of shot warms up when 2nd flight of discus ends Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order), worst to best, then finals Three throws, top 9 to finals for 3 more throws 15 minute warm up prior to each flight
	Long Jump*	Flights 1, 2, simultaneously, followed by flight 3 Three jumps, top 9 to finals for 3 more jumps 15 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight Flights 2 and 3 will both be on the same runway
	Triple Jump*	First flight of triple begins when finals of long begin Flights 1, 2, 3(in order) worst to best, Three jumps, top 9 to finals for 3 more jumps 10 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight Flights 2 and 3 will both be on the same runway

High Jump Best Flight first (**5 cm bar moves** until 1.90m then by 2 cm)

Opening Height of Flight 1 (1.60m = 5'3")

Opening Height of Flight 2 (1.50m = 4'11")

15 minute warm up between flights **Q(1.9m = 6-3")**

Pole Vault Best Flight first (**15 cm bar moves** until 4.16m then by 7 cm)

Opening Height of Flight 1 (2.96m = 9'8.5")

Opening Height of Flight 2 (2.66 m = 8'8")

15 minute warm up between flight **Q(4.16m = 13'8")**

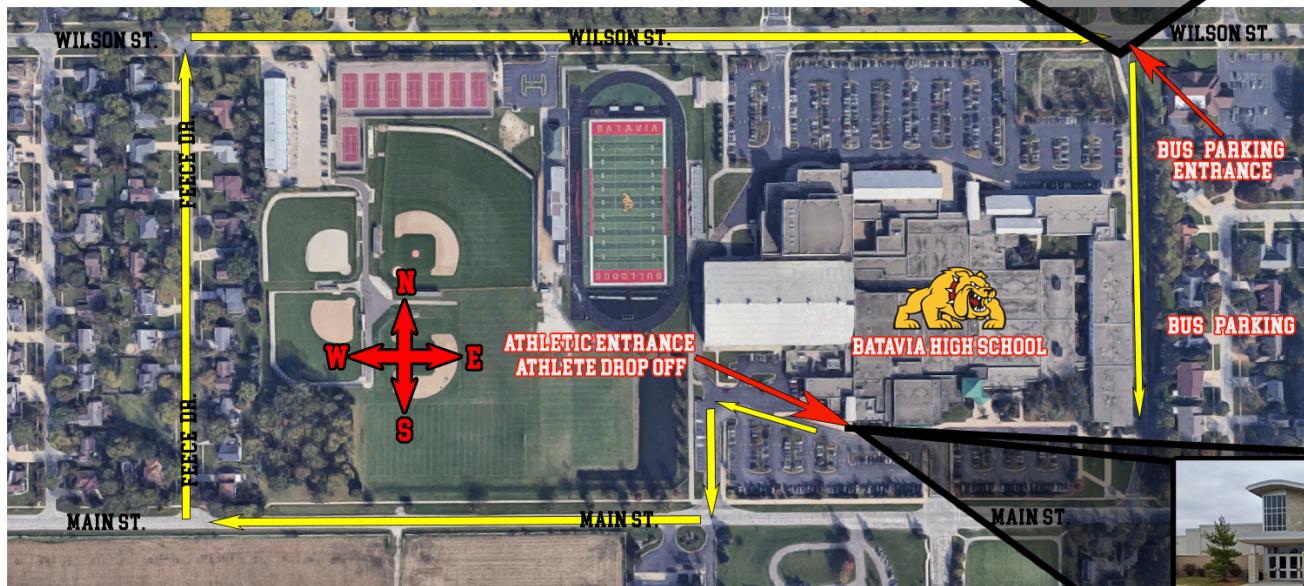
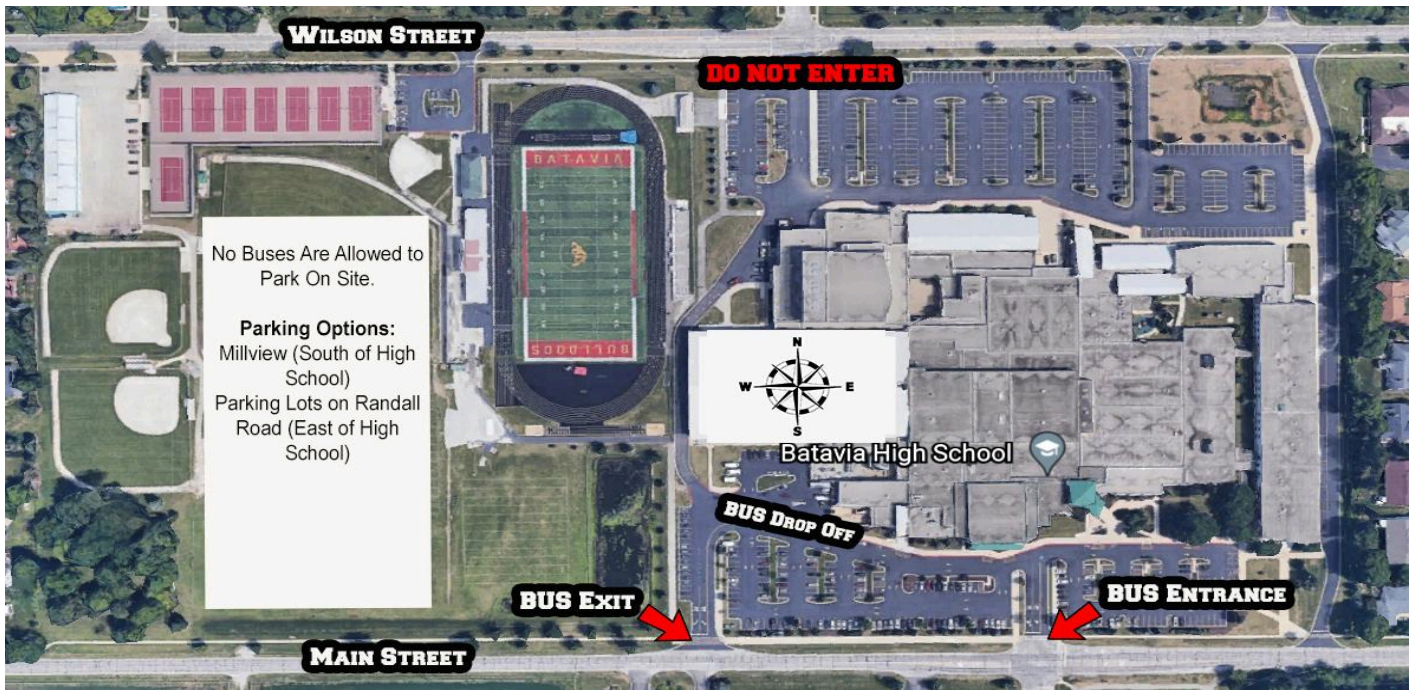
