5. God (in monotheistic societies)
6. Titles like Dr. Mr. Mrs.
7. Names of Languages like English or Latin
8. Names of buildings like The White House, The Senate
9. Historical events (like the Civil War)
10. North/South/East/West as a region of the country.

**The following items are NOT capitalized.**

1. Subjects like math, history, science
2. Seasons
3. The words mother, father, sister, daughter, or son, or brother (except for nuns and priests)
4. Words like man, woman, book, etc (common nouns)
5. North, south, east, west as directions on a map.
