

3P DOMINION TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The tournament will be a Swiss-style tournament.

In the Swiss rounds, players will be split into games of three or four players, with as many 3-player games as possible. For the first round, players will be seeded randomly; after the first round, players will be placed with other players who have similar scores. Players will not play the same kingdom twice, but may have to play against the same player(s) more than once, though this will try to be avoided.

Players will be given tournament points based on the results of their games.

For a 3-player game:

1st place scores 5 points
2nd place scores 3 points
3rd place scores 1 point

For a 4-player game:

1st place scores 6 points
2nd place scores 4 points
3rd place scores 2 points
4th place scores 0 points

In case of a tie, all players tied will split the points for the positions they are tied for equally. For example, if two players are tied for second place in a 3-player game, they will split 2nd and 3rd place points equally, so they will each get 2 points.

There will be 4 Swiss rounds to the tournament. Depending on the number of people that start the tournament, at the end of the Swiss rounds, a certain number of people will advance (below) to the next phase of the competition, which will be second set of 4 Swiss rounds. Highest total point scores will advance, with a tiebreaker game being played if necessary. In case of a tiebreaker, number of first-place game finishes may be used as a preliminary tiebreaker to prevent a tiebreaker game involving five or more people at the moderator's discretion.

11 or less people: 4 Swiss rounds, no second round

12 or more people: 4 Swiss rounds, 9 people advance

PRIZES

Dominion Promo cards will be given to all participants on a first-come, first-served basis in order of registration until supplies run out. The winner of the tournament will be pre-qualified for the finals of the Dominion World National tournament at Gencon in 2018.

For each entry into the tournament, 80% of the entry fee will be put into the prize pool. All prizes will be given in store credit. The prize pool will be divided between the top finishers to determine the prizes as follows:

18 or less people:

1st place gets 50% of the prize pool

2nd place gets 30% of the prize pool

3rd place gets 20% of the prize pool

19 or more people:

1st place gets 45% of the prize pool

2nd place gets 25% of the prize pool

3rd place gets 20% of the prize pool

4th place gets 10% of the prize pool

Actual prize values may be slightly different than these percentages so that all prizes may be even dollar amounts.
