
#29 Elementary Math Quiz

#1. High School Reading Quiz

Hold students responsible for reading assignments by giving a simple quiz. This example is based on *Fahrenheit 451 for* a high school English classroom.

This form is configured to release the quiz score immediately after submitting the quiz, something you may NOT want to do in your own classroom if you teach multiple sections.

#2. Google Classroom Video Quiz

This form features short videos which teach students about the key parts of Google Classroom.

Following each video, students are asked a series of comprehension questions to check their understanding.

Students must earn a mastery score of 80% in order to complete this assignment.

Tip: Adding video to a quiz adds interest and improves comprehension. Videos must be uploaded to YouTube in order to be added to a Form.



#4 Mood Check-in




#5 Permission slip

Field trips are fun. Permission slips are not. This form allows parents to digitally sign permission slips.

Tip: to prevent students from completing their own permission slip, a parent email address is required and a notification is sent to this email address using **Form Postman**.

Choice eliminator is used to remove student names from the drop-down list once permission has been given. This makes it easy for a teacher to identify which students do not have a permission slip on file.

#6 Library book recommendation


Encourage students to share their book recommendation by completing this form.

#7 Lab Data Collection


Simplify data collection and analysis for your next lab activity!

#8 Yearbook Photo Page


Google Forms has a file upload feature that you can use to collect digital files.






#25 LIVE Reading log


#26 Classroom Observations
