LESSON TITLE: Aliens Love Underpants	LESSON GOAL : The students will learn about how to create art using the rolled paper technique.
INTRODUCE THE BOOK/STORY: (Read the story or use the video link.)	We have a funny video story today, it is: VIDEO BOOK LINK: Aliens Love Underpants by Claire Freedman & Ben Cort
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: (Check for Understanding)	 Have you ever seen clean laundry hung on a line? What kind of games do the aliens play in the clean underwear What should you check for before putting on your clean underpants?
SUPPLIES NEEDED: Paper plate, permanent marker, watercolor markers, glue, wiggle eyes, glitter glue (optional)	ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION: What kind of space vehicles can you imagine that aliens from outer space might use? What shape are they? What do they look like?
ACTIVITY (Students should do their own work):	Paper Plate Alien craft
CLOSING DISCUSSION: (Review activity through discussion or questions).	Did you like the way your Alien ship turned out? Was it hard to create art with rolled paper? Here is a fun link to: Funny Alien Jokes
GROUP GAME: Developmental Goal: To develop verbal communication, strategic thinking, and hand-eye coordination.
