Shamrock Leaf Lace Edging The Lady's Worktable 4 March, 1871

Material. — Ardern's crochet cotton, No. 40.

Terms: D double, P. purl.

Begin with the shamrock, having two threads (i.e. with shuttle and ball). Make a loop, 6.D., 1 P., 4 D., 1 P., 6 D., draw close, leave a short space of cotton and repeat the above twice; then with 2nd thread (from ball) work round the first oval, * 7 D., 1 P., join in the P. of oval, 5 D., 1 P., join to next P., 5 D., 1 P., join to the last P., 7 D.; to fix the cotton firmly bring the 2nd thread through the centre (i.e. into the gap between rings), and make a stitch; repeat * round the other two ovals.

To work the stalk reverse the work, and with 2nd thread (work a chain of) 7 D., join to P. of the last oval of shamrock, 1 D., 1 P., 5 D., reverse, and with shuttle (make a ring of) 6D., join to next P. in shamrock, 6 D., draw close, reverse with 2nd thread, 4 D., 1 P., 5 D., reverse with shuttle, 6 D., 1P., 6 D., draw close, reverse with 2nd thread, 7 D., 1 P., 1 D., fasten off; repeat the above till you have the length of the shamrock required.

For the top row of trefoil begin with 1st oval, * 7 D., 1 P., 7 D., draw close. Work close to this 2nd oval, 7 D., 1 P., 7 D., draw close. — 3rd oval. 7 D., 1 P., 7 D., draw close. Reverse with 2nd thread 10 D., 1 P., 10 D.; reverse and repeat from * for the length required. To connect this with the shamrock, work with shuttle only, 6 D., join to P. in 1st oval of trefoil, 6 D., draw close, reverse, 6 D., join to 1st P. in the stitch of the shamrock, 6 D., draw close. Leave a very short space of cotton, 2 D., join to 2nd oval of trefoil, 2 D., draw close, reverse 6 D., join to next P. in the stalk, 6 D., draw close; repeat this to the end.

For the outside row of trefoils have 2 threads, make a loop, § 6 D., 1 P., 6 D., draw close. Work close to this 3 D., 1 P., 3 D., draw close. Reverse the work, and with 2nd thread 2 D., 1 P., 2 D., 1 P., 2 D., 1 P., 4 D. Reverse, and work 1st oval of trefoil, 7 D., join to P. of last oval, 7 D., draw close. Work close to this 2nd oval 7 D., 1 P., 7 D., draw close.— 3rd oval. 7 D., 1 P., 7 D., draw close. Reverse with 2nd thread 2 D., 1 P. 7 times, 2 D. Reverse, and repeat the trefoil as before ; then reverse, and work from § to the end.

This last row is joined to the shamrocks by dots of 6 D., joining to every P. of the sham-rocks and trefoils 6D., draw close.

Shamrock Lace edging By R. J. R.

Translation: Craftree

Begin with two shuttles together.

Shuttle 1: 3x (R 6-4-4-6, short length of thread equal to 1ds.)

Shuttle 2: 3x (R 7-+5-+5, joining to previous rings of shamrock after each picot.)

Snug up any extra by passing the second shuttle through the center and making a stitch.
