## "My Cultural Eye" Poster Assignment

This assignment involves some critical thinking, creative visual compilation, and presentation. You will each create a "cultural eye" poster using the following criteria as the minimum requirements for the assignment.

- The minimum size for your poster is 12" x 18" and the maximum for your poster is 14" x 21". You may use any color for the poster.
- The current draft of your cultural eye chart with at least 5 lenses (think aesthetic presentation)
- A short paragraph describing each of the cultural eye lenses, including an
  example of how it shapes the way you look at the world (can be on the front or
  back).
- 4 personal pictures with you in them somewhere.
- 2 quotes that you get from someone that knows you. Examples: "Andrew caters too much to the inner geek in his students." "If Mr. Giddings goes off on one more history tangent, I'm going to scream."
- 4 words that describe the way you perceive yourself. These may be cut from a
  magazine or newspaper or drawn by you or a friend. Look for different font
  styles and size variation. Remember, think presentation.
- 4 additions, i.e., clip art, stickers, cut-outs, "stuff", anything to beautify...

These are the minimum requirements. You are welcome to go far above the specifications, but remember that sometimes less is more (if it's not Baroque, that can be a good thing). Do work to make your poster aesthetically pleasing with balance in the layout of the components listed above. You will need to put your name, date, and period on the back.
