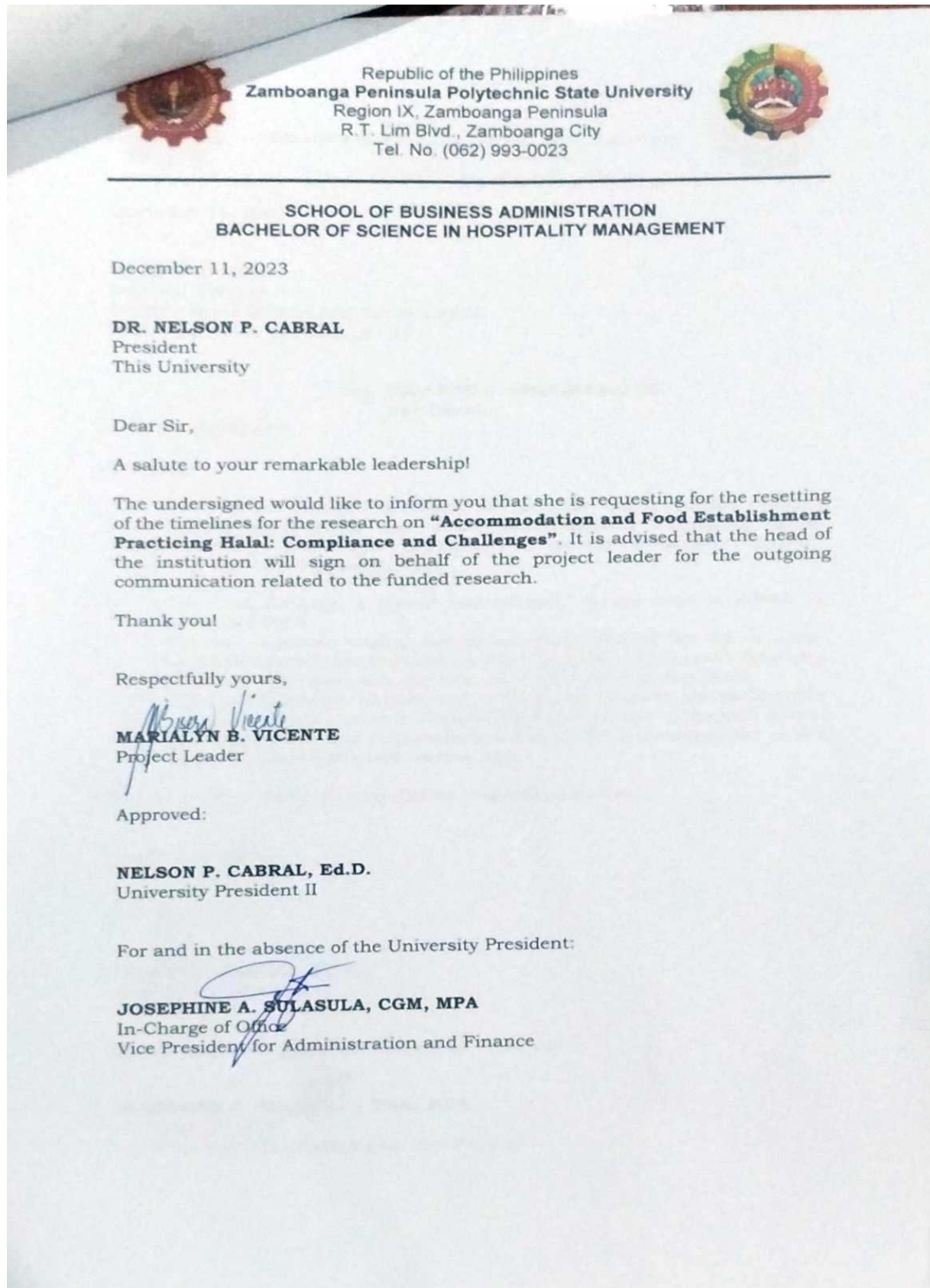

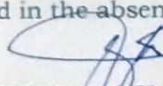

ZPPSU receives P656,000 DOST Research Grant

Zamboanga Peninsula Polytechnic State University (ZPPSU) was awarded a substantial grant worth P656,000 for a halal-based study, which was authored by Asst. Professors Marialyn B. Vicente one of the SBA Regular Faculty and Dr. Jason V. Chavez one of the SBA's Allied Faculty member from the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Regional Office IX on November 10, this year.

The grant was officially handed over to ZPPSU President Dr. Nelson P. Cabral by esteemed guests, including DOST City Director for CSTC Zamboanga and Isabela as well as the OIC - Assistant Regional Director for Field Offices Mr. John Apolinario III, together with the DOST staff; Ms. Judilyn Alvarez, Mr. Jan Carlo Tangon, and Mr. Benzar Kazan.

The turnover of the fund is the first external funding for a research project as a university.
