Be it enacted by the Associated Students at the University of New Mexico that the following be amended in <i>(Section 2302)</i> of the ASUNM Law Book:
Article 2300: Community Experience
Section 2301. Purpose
The purpose of the Community Experience (CE) shall be to encourage community public service and provide connect the University of New Mexico's undergraduate community with

Section 2302. Membership

Community Experience will comprise of:

volunteering, sustainability, cultural and service opportunities

- A. Executive Director, appointed by the President and approved by the President Pro Tempore and the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The Executive Director will be responsible for:
 - a. Presiding over all meetings of the Community Experience; and
 - b. Making all necessary appoints for the Community Experience including, but not

limited to, Communications Director, Events Director, and Projects

Director; Assistant Director, Volunteer Coordinator, and Cultural Director

- c. Managing all fiscal expenditures of the Community Experience; and
- d. Ensuring the maintenance of a list of community service programs and events available to the University of New Mexico community; and
- e. Performing any other task necessary to the success of the Community Experience.
- B. Assistant Director, appointed by the Executive Director and approved by the President Pro

Tempore and the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The Assistant Director will be responsible for:

- a. Assisting the Executive Director in setting agendas; and
- b. Participating in meetings on behalf of the agency or the Executive Director; and
- c. Fulfilling any further duties assigned by the Executive Director.
- C. Volunteer Coordinator, appointed by the Executive Director and approved by the President Pro Tempore and the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The Volunteer Coordinator will be responsible for:
 - a. Coordinating regularly scheduled volunteer meetings; and
 - b. Research and coordinate community service projects.
- D. Cultural Director, appointed by the Executive Director and approved by the President Pro Tempore and the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The Cultural Director will be responsible for:
 - a. Coordinating a variety of free cultural events service opportunities for the undergraduate student population with the consultation of the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion; and
 - b. Assisting in the coordination of outreach to local organizations and initiatives and:

- c. Working closely with the Volunteer Coordinator to ensure diverse student groups are connected to volunteer opportunities; and
- d. Assisting other directors in outreaching to the community.
