### **Apache Beam 2.2.0 Release** (by: Reuven Lax)

### **Bundle Retry for the Python SDK DirectRunner** (by: María García Herrero)

- Beam Python is now more reliable, as it includes a mechanism for the DirectRunner to process bundles up to 4 times and makes sure there are no partial write-outs if a retry occurs.
- The feature is currently opt-in by using the --direct\_runner\_bundle\_retry flag.

### **Extension for Data Sketches** (by: Arnaud Fournier)

- A new extension library of Combiners using probabilistic data structures (data sketches).
- The first sketch ApproximateDistinct (aka HyperLogLog+) is already in master, CountMinSketch and t-digest are expected to arrive before the end of the year.
