

Notice of Board Opening for a Non-AHEPA Director (June 2026 – June 2029)

Teacher Director Representing the Greek Program

The Board is seeking applicants for the position of Teacher Director representing the Greek Program for the term of June 2026 through June 2029.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Teachers who teach Greek Language and Culture or Math in Greek
- Teachers who actively participate in Greek Department structures, including weekly PLCs, targeted professional development, and departmental meetings
- Teachers who are included in the Greek Department's weekly updates in Greek
- Teachers who are evaluated under DTGSS with specific and measurable goals set by the Greek Department related to Greek language and culture, which guide their instructional practice and departmental responsibilities

While these criteria are strongly recommended to help ensure candidates are well-positioned to represent the Greek Program, applicants who feel they can effectively serve in this role despite not meeting all criteria are still encouraged to apply. Please address this in your letter of interest and explain how your experience and perspective would allow you to successfully represent the position.

A current resume that includes:

- Their current teaching role
- Any certifications held

A cover letter that includes:

- A brief letter of interest explaining why they are interested in serving in this role
