This hinders my academic timeline and transfer requirements, increases financial burden on my family and puts my F1 at risk.

I am a College Now student hoping to major in Data Analytics in college. The colleges I am applying to want to see 3 levels of Calculus and a Linear Algebra class on my transcript. If I were not to take either of these classes, I risk being rescinded by the university I choose to attend.

### Thandar Nyunt (CWID)

I am an international student from Myanmar, majoring in Aerospace engineering. I need this class to enroll in my Physics 4B, further Math, and Engineering classes. My student visa has an I-20 form, which has regulations on my studies' end date. If I don't get this class, I'm gonna have to face more difficult problems in the future. Additionally, the admission and records put my enrollment time 30 minutes later.

### Yiquan Wei (Evie) (CWID)

Missing this class will delay my transfer by a year, increasing tuition and living expenses, which would put a heavy financial strain on my family. As an international student, the added time and costs would heighten my stress while I navigate the expiration of my I-20, potentially putting my F-1 visa at risk. Most heartbreaking is the possibility that my father, battling Grade IV brain cancer, may not be able to see me graduate as he wishes.

### Yucheng Wei (Ella) (CWID)

As an international student, my tuition is very expensive, and I'm currently working part-time at ISP to help manage my expenses. If my graduation is delayed due to missing this course, it will increase my financial burden significantly. The additional costs would create a lot of stress and impact both my academic progress and daily life.

### George Petviashvili (CWID)

I am a high school student, taking this class for the third time. I have made a commitment to another college about doing Math 1C. I had no possibility of getting into this class as I was on a late pass, by the time my pass rolled around, the class was full. If I don't get this, I will have to postpone my transfer to the next year as I need Physics for the transfer.
