Winter 2022 COVID-19 Certification Form

THE “NEW NORMAL” DURING COVID-19

Since the global COVID-19 pandemic, the New Bedford Whaling Museum has adopted new policies and procedures to help ensure the health and safety of visitors, staff, and volunteers.

Masks and Face Coverings

- **All visitors, staff, and volunteers are required to wear masks while in the museum regardless of vaccination status.** Participants and program staff of “Celebrating Women & Work” will be required to wear masks or face coverings at all times while indoors, and practice social distancing during snack times. Masks will be required on buses to field trips.

Vaccination

- **Participants of “Celebrating Women and Work” are required to be fully vaccinated.** A person is considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna) or ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the single dose of the Janssen vaccine.

Museum Safety Measures

In addition to around-the-clock cleaning and disinfecting routines, the Museum has installed UVC air purification systems throughout the building, which reduce the spread of viruses and bacteria in the air and on surfaces. Participants will have access to hand washing capabilities and all high-touch areas will be regularly sanitized during the program.
