# <u>1st Floor</u>

### **Counseling Office & Future Center**

- South has 6 counselors that are broken up by alphabetical order and are with you all four years as a student. They support you academically, socially and emotionally.
- The Future Center is supported by the Denver Scholarship Foundation and helps seniors with the college application process, financial aid and scholarships. Seniors can be in here any time to work on apps and get support.

### **Culture Team**

• The culture team is where our Deans are located. This is the place you go if you are having conflicts with your friends or other students, need attendance support or are caught doing anything that is against the student handbook. They are here to help!

#### **Athletics Office**

• This is where you go to find out all the information about athletics at South. We will talk more about this in the student panels.

### Senate Room (105)

• This is where the Senate meets every day. Student Senate organizes all school wide events and activities. Mr. Ortega's (Activity Director) office is also where you go to find out information about all the clubs offered at South.

#### **Denver Health + School Nurse**

You have to opt in to be able to utilize the services in Denver Health but we have a
full time Nurse Practitioner, A Healthy Relationships liaison, Substance Abuse
Support, Mental Health Support, and you can get your physicals done for sports in
Denver Health. Day to day sickness or anything else can be taken care of by our
school nurse.

### **JROTC**

JROTC is an elective course taught at Denver South. The Junior Reserve Officers'
 Training Corps is one of the largest character development and citizenship
 programs for youth in the United States - the mission is to "Motivate young people
 to be better citizens."

- Although sponsored and funded by the military, there is *no obligation* or pressure to join the military. In fact, less than 1% of students enrolled in JROTC will ever wear a military uniform.
- Denver South's JROTC program, the 1st Battalion, has been one of the best Army JROTC programs in the nation for the last 40+ years and proudly wears the gold star on their uniform as an Honor Unit of Distinction.
