## Upcoming EQAO Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics

On Wednesday, June 17th, and during the exam block, our Grade 9 students in Grade 9 math courses will be taking part in the Education Quality and Accountability Office's (EQAO's) online Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics. This assessment aims to evaluate students' learning of the knowledge and skills in the Grade 9 mathematics curriculum.

Students will complete the assessment in two sessions (Session A and Session B). Session A will occur on Wednesday, June 17th, and Session B will occur during the final examination block. The assessment will automatically adapt to the individual student's level of proficiency as the student progresses through each session. Additional time will be provided for any students who require it. After completing both sessions, students will also be prompted to complete a questionnaire about their experiences, attitudes, and perceptions towards math.

After the assessment sessions are complete, teachers will receive individual student results that will count toward 10% of their final course mark.
