### Lesson Activities

Objective/Goal: Grammar Practice, Find Key Details, and Write a Summary

Activity/Outline:

1. Follow this link to Google Classroom and read this post:

1. Click Log in with Google and use your school email address.
2. Work on the assignments that are listed for you.

- B. WEDNESDAY-FRIDAY:

1. Open a google document and share it with your teacher- Include your name, date, and Title (San Diego Zoo- **Animal Name Here**)
2. Go to this site: <https://kids.sandiegozoo.org/>
3. Click Animals- Then choose which animal you would like to write about and scroll through the first section labeled FACTS
4. Answer the following questions in COMPLETE, GRAMMATICALLY CORRECT SENTENCES (must include capitalization and punctuation):
  - a. Where is your animal found?
  - b. How endangered is your animal?
  - c. What type of habitat does your animal live in?
  - d. Provide one other fact of your choice.
5. Next, Scroll down to the details about your animal and LIST 3 DETAILS about your animal. If your animal has any unique features list 1 of them. Again this should be done in COMPLETE, GRAMMATICALLY CORRECT SENTENCES (must include capitalization and punctuation).
6. At the bottom of the page it will have activities listed. WATCH the video about your animal and write a summary about what you watched.
  - a. HINT: Write about what you would tell someone who had never seen the video. Highlight fun facts and describe what your animal is doing in the video.
7. Last, answer the following questions:

- a. What is your favorite thing about your animal?
  - b. Have you ever seen your animal?
  - c. Did you like this project?
  - d. Name three other animals you would like to know more about.
  - e. Post of photo at the end of your document of your animal!!
8. If you go back to the page about your animal you'll find that the activities section also has games and at home projects you can do! I recommend checking these out and having a bit of fun with it! (THIS IS NOT REQUIRED).
9. Re-read your document to check for spelling and grammar mistakes- be sure to fix any mistakes you find!
10. This assignment is due by the end of the day on Friday, April 3rd.
