Frequently Asked Questions About Glaucoma

1. What Is Glaucoma?

Glaucoma is a group of eye conditions that damage the **optic nerve**, usually due to high pressure inside the eye (called **intraocular pressure** or IOP). Over time, this damage can lead to vision loss — and even blindness — if not treated.

There are multiple types of glaucoma, including:

- Primary open-angle glaucoma (POAG) the most common type
- Angle-closure glaucoma less common, but more sudden and severe
- Normal-tension glaucoma damage occurs even with normal eye pressure
- Congenital glaucoma present from birth
- Secondary glaucoma caused by other medical conditions or medications

2. What Causes Glaucoma?

Glaucoma is usually caused by **inefficient drainage** of fluid in the eye, which leads to pressure buildup. However, it can also be influenced by other factors:

- Family history
- Age (especially over 60)
- Diabetes or high blood pressure
- Previous eye trauma
- Prolonged steroid use
- Thin corneas or high myopia

Not everyone with high eye pressure develops glaucoma — and some people with normal pressure do. That's why **comprehensive testing** is essential.

3. What Are the Symptoms of Glaucoma?

In its early stages, glaucoma often has no symptoms. As it progresses, you may experience:

- Loss of peripheral (side) vision
- Blurred or tunnel vision
- Halos around lights

- Eye pain (especially with angle-closure glaucoma)
- Nausea or vomiting (in emergencies)

Because early symptoms are rare, **routine eye exams are critical** for detection — especially if you're over 60 or have other risk factors.

4. Can Glaucoma Be Cured?

There is currently **no cure for glaucoma**, but with early detection and proper treatment, it can be **successfully managed**.

The goal of treatment is to **lower eye pressure** and prevent further optic nerve damage. While any vision already lost can't be restored, timely treatment can help protect your remaining sight.

5. What Are the Treatment Options for Glaucoma?

Treatment depends on the type and severity of your glaucoma. Options include:

- Prescription eye drops to lower pressure
- Laser therapy like SLT or LPI to improve drainage
- Minimally Invasive Glaucoma Surgery (MIGS)
- Traditional surgery like trabeculectomy or tube shunts

7. How Is Glaucoma Diagnosed?

A glaucoma evaluation includes several painless tests:

- Tonometry measures eye pressure
- Optical coherence tomography (OCT) images the optic nerve
- Visual field test checks peripheral vision
- Gonioscopy examines the eye's drainage angle
- Pachymetry measures corneal thickness

8. How Often Do I Need to Be Checked for Glaucoma?

That depends on your age and risk factors:

- Age 40–54: every 2–4 years
- Age 55-64: every 1-3 years
- Age 65+: every 1–2 years

If you already have glaucoma, your specialist will set a customized follow-up schedule based on your condition.

9. Is Glaucoma Painful?

Most types of glaucoma — especially **open-angle glaucoma** — are painless in early stages.

However, acute angle-closure glaucoma can cause:

- Sudden eye pain
- Redness
- Blurred vision

Nausea or vomiting

This is a medical emergency and requires **immediate treatment** to avoid permanent vision loss.

10. What's the Difference Between Glaucoma and Cataracts?

- Glaucoma damages the optic nerve and causes permanent vision loss, usually starting with peripheral vision.
- Cataracts cloud the eye's natural lens and cause reversible vision problems that can be corrected with surgery.
