

Cost of Attendance includes tuition, fees, room and board (housing – living with a family member or on their own), books, supplies, transportation, and personal expenses.

For financial aid calculations, determining financial need:

- 1. Determine the student's **Cost of Attendance (COA)**.
- 2. Need the student's **Student Aid Index (SAI)**, which is calculated when the student files the FAFSA.
- 3. Formula to determine financial need of aid to be awarded:

COA - SAI = Financial Need
