The rain, though brief, was so heavy, a handful of players withdrew after getting soaked on the first holes. Another bunch called to cancel that morning, or just didn't show. The proshop expects green fees to be paid before the last group tees off, but the player count was nearly impossible to determine at that time. The scorecards submitted may have set a record for errors and omissions. Only six of 24 cards were completed correctly. The errors included recording net scores, instead of gross, using a different Stableford point allocation, abundant math errors, omitting total scores, illegible scores and not posting any score.
