Learning Foci

Structured Literacy -We will continue using a daily structured approach of teaching for literacy based programmes in reading, writing, handwriting and spelling.

<u>Maths</u>

Year 3

NUMBER OPERATIONS-Fractions- Read, write, compare and order fractions and find equivalent fractions.

Measurement- Time - telling the time (hour, 1/2 hour, quarter past/to (analogue/digital) Pathways - maps and directions

Number structure and operations Explore and choose appropriate mental multiplication and division strategies such as doubling, halving and using known number facts Explore and choose appropriate written multiplication methods such as the split method and the grid method to solve problems involving one- and two-digit numbers

Statistics Understand and use the features of common data displays such as picture graphs and column graphs.

Draw conclusions from data presented in graphs, and compare the effectiveness of different data displays

Patterns and algebra Interpret, represent and solve word problems, and find missing numbers to balance equations.

Financial mathematics Explore different combinations of coins to make a total, calculate change and round to the nearest ten cents

Inquiry - Our Social Studies inquiry focus is "The Way We Were." An inquiry into how life has changed in New Zealand over time.
