To better serve our students across our community, Jeffco Schools administers student engagement surveys and social emotional learning (SEL) skills screeners throughout the school year. Our student engagement survey and secondary SEL screener are conducted by Panorama – a company who conducts surveys in schools and districts across the country. Our elementary SEL screener is administered through Pearson.

How is this data used?

The Jeffco Listens survey results are compiled into aggregate-level school reports. These reports will be used by school staff to help maintain the positive aspects of our schools and to address individual student needs.

The SEL screener results are compiled into both individual and group summaries of social emotional skill progress. These reports are used by district leaders and school staff to guide our development of school-wide, small group, and/or individual social emotional support. You will be notified if your child is invited to join a small group or individual intervention.

It is Voluntary. Your child does not have to take the student survey or be screened by their teacher. Students who participate only have to answer the questions they want to answer and they may stop taking the survey at any time.

It is Confidential. No students will be identified in any public reports or publications. Individual student information (name, student number, school, and grade) will be uploaded into the Panorama and/or Pearson system. District staff will have access to the data file. Responses are confidential but identifiable. Individual student data may be shared with school staff to provide instructional and social emotional support.

Timing: The Panorama surveys and SSIS SEL screener will be administered up to three times a year. The SEL screeners will be administered in the fall, winter, and optionally in the spring. It will take about 20 minutes.
