

This guy has a stylish looking jacket, I want it, and one day I'll get it. James' jacket is very cool, but where did it come from?

Fucking Vietnam, thats where.

But I know what some of you may be thinking, "How the fuck did you come to that conclusion".

I'll tell you how, but before we get to James, we gotta talk about Frank Sunderland.

He's old. How old? No-one knows for sure, however, it's often theorized that he is somewhere in his 60's. For the sake of argument, let's say that during the events of Silent Hill 4, Frank is 65.
