# **Fundraising Ideas**

- Community Night Outs tax-exemption is not yet working. Setting these up for a straight 20% back of profits to Slauson
- Tiger Field has a program for group sales and special days for students. Power of Purpose (POP) field day/fun run comes to the school and sets up. Fundraising aspect is that students have to raise money.

### 8th Grade Graduation

The Detroit Princess field trip reservation was made for Tuesday, June 6th. Tentative plans to share the boat with Forsythe Middle School. The boat ride includes unlimited soft drinks for students with DJ/music. A letter will be sent to 8th grade families asking for \$75/student for the entire 8th grade "experiences", including Detroit Princess, Revel and Roll and Graduation Party. *Note: Algebra 2 students will have high school finals on June 6th. Accommodations will be made for these handful of students.* 

### 6th / 7th Grade Fun Nights

Fun Night dates open for the entire school. Jan. 13 and March 17. Wristbands will be pre-sold for Fun Night around \$5 each. Fun nights are evening activities when one gym is open for gym activities. The art room would be open for creative activities. One cafeteria is also open with games. Pizza and cookies would be provided to students. Fun nights heavily rely on parent volunteers and can only happen with enough volunteers.

### **Teacher Appreciation**
