Volunteer Position Description: Facilitate and plan outdoor adventures, fun activities, crafts, games, and songs for a group of similarly-aged kids at a five day session of Tumalo Day Camp. Volunteers will be assigned a teenage Counselor In



Training (CIT) during the week who will be there to assist in organizing/prepping for activities, running fun games, and supporting with general supervision of youth.

Details:

- There are three 5-day sessions of day camp. Each session, counselors are assigned a group of 8-10 youth who are grouped by grade: PreK through 7th.
- Each day of camp has a different theme (ie: Crazy Hair, Backwards Day, etc.)
- Under the guidance of the Camp Director, Counselors will follow a set curriculum teaching outdoor skills, arts and crafts, games, hikes, outdoor cooking, camping skills and more.
 Additionally, counselors are encouraged to bring their own skill set to share with the campers!
- Counselors leading 4th, 5th, and 6th grades will go on a one-night overnighter with their group at Tumalo State Park campgrounds on Thursday night of the camp. 7th grade groups camp for 2 nights on Wednesday and Thursday nights.
- We have a certified nurse on site during day camp hours.
- Funds are provided for supplies parking passes provided too.
- Volunteer camp counselors send their kids to camp for FREE!

Training: One-day mandatory training at Tumalo State Park, **Sunday June 8th, 9am-2pm**. Lunch is

Requirements: All volunteers must pass a background check
