What can you expect regarding grades on Renweb?

While assignments will be returned to students either through hard copies or digitally via Google Classroom, grades will be officially documented in Renweb. Additionally, Renweb is where students and parents can view the student's cumulative grade for the nine-weeks and other important grade-related information.





Staying Organized

What are helpful ways to keep track of assignments and upcoming due dates?

There are three ways to keep track of assignments and upcoming due dates in Google Classroom.

- Home Screen The Home Screen organizes assignments due within one week by listing them under the tile for the appropriate class.
- Calendar The Calendar organizes assignments for all classes in a single weekly calendar format.
- To-do The To-do list filters assignments for all classes by "Assigned," "Missing," and "Done."



Daily Recaps

How can I review a lesson?

"Daily Recaps" are posted by 4:00 pm every afternoon. They include the following information for each class:

- Learning target (What was the primary learning goal for the day?)
- Tasks completed in class
- Homework
- Upcoming assessments
- Class recording
- Important attachments including rubrics, slides, websites, notes, videos, etc. . . .

Google Classroom Tutorial



TrekAl

TrekAl is an artificial intelligence program specifically designed to provide academic tutoring and is available to all students at CAC's Secondary Campus. This program is designed with age-appropriate safeguards that align with CAC's Christian values, curriculum, and pedagogical methods.

While the unapproved use of AI is prohibited at the Secondary Campus (see the Student Handbook for more information), students are always welcome to utilize TrekAI as a "study buddy" or personalized tutor. Students will be able to:

- Ask questions about content they're struggling with
- Receive feedback aligned to class rubrics
- Engage in guided conversations that promote critical thinking through the Socratic method

TrekAl is built with academic integrity in mind. It does not auto-complete assignments or give direct answers. Instead, it prompts students with thoughtful questions to encourage independent thinking and the responsible use of technology.
