3.1) Creating a basic page for The Club

Create a CLUB view

resources/view/club.blade.php

```
<h1>TheClub</h1>

<p>About</p>
<p>Contact</p>
<p>Register</p>
```

From ClubController call Club view

app/Http/Controllers/ClubController.php

```
<?php
namespace App\Http\Controllers;
use Illuminate\Http\Request;

class ClubController extends Controller
{
    public function index(Request $request)
    {
        return view ("club");
    }
}
```

Create a route for ClubController

routes/web.php

```
Route::get('/club', 'App\Http\Controllers\ClubController@index');
```

    contact the club  
@stop
```

views/pages/register.blade.php

@extends('layouts.default')  
@section('content')
```

register with the club
@stop
```

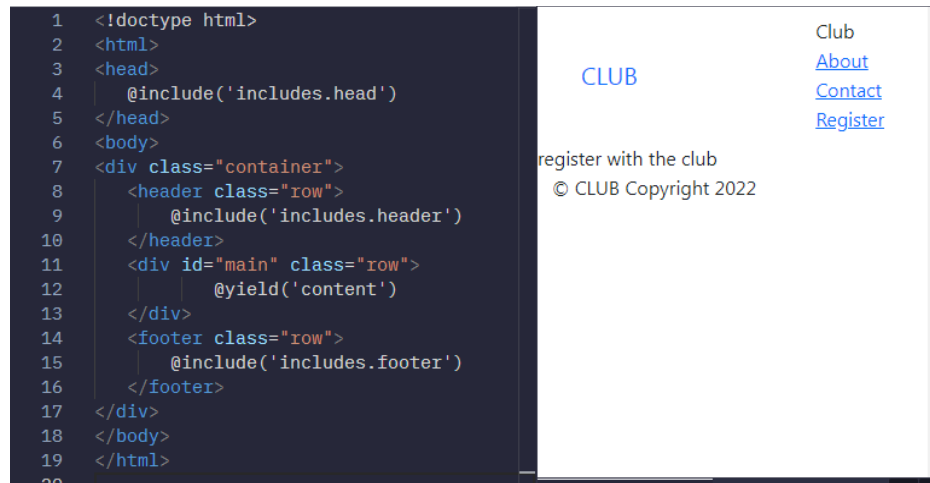
