

To the General Medical Council

We are writing to object to your decision to suspend the medical licences of Dr Diana Warner and Dr Sarah Benn following their conviction and imprisonment for participation in peaceful climate protests.

Drs Warner and Benn took part in actions with Insulate Britain and Just Stop Oil which aimed to increase public awareness of the Climate Emergency and to insist on the obligation of governments to take action commensurate with the scale of the threat. Climate change has been widely recognised as a leading threat to physical and mental health; *The Lancet Countdown* stated unequivocally in 2023 that 'global health lies at the mercy of fossil fuels' and argued that 'averting the worst impacts of climate change requires profound and immediate systemic changes'. Given the spectacular failure of attempts to secure those changes over the last half-century, people of conscience, including many medical professionals, have increasingly turned to civil disobedience as a way to effect change. The new forms of direct action have had demonstrable results. The first Extinction Rebellion protests in 2018-19 led to the declaration of a Climate Emergency by the UK Parliament in 2019. And following waves of protests by Insulate Britain and Just Stop Oil, the UK now has a government that is committed to their key demands: a programme of mass home insulation and an end to the issuing of new licences to drill for oil and gas in the North Sea.

Billions of lives are being put at risk by rising global temperatures. The world has just had 14 consecutive months of record-breaking heat, with sea-surface temperatures that have smashed previous limits and a succession of extreme weather events that should cause grave alarm to anyone who bears any responsibility for the safety and security of life on earth. In the view of many climate scientists, the Paris Agreement goals of limiting global temperature rises to well below 2°C above pre-industrial levels are slipping out of reach, and we are being ushered into a world of far higher temperature rises, with terrifying implications for the viability of human societies and the ecosystems on which they depend. The law currently protects the interests of the corporations that cause planetary devastation and criminalises those who are fighting for our collective right to a habitable biosphere. We call on the GMC to reverse these suspensions and to show its support for those who have sacrificed their freedom in calling for the 'deep, rapid and sustained reductions in greenhouse gas emissions' which (according to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change) are humanity's last hope.
