THE ASSIGNMENT

Students can submit any video <u>created during the school year</u> that addresses the prompt below. Submissions to KSPA monthly contests year are eligible to be submitted for this regional contest as well.

Your news program has assigned you to cover recent STEM activities at your school. Many people define STEM as anything related to **science**, **technology**, **engineering or math**. Consider how you can create video news coverage of students, teachers and others in a newsworthy STEM-related environment.

Of course, this contest expects that you act ethically. Those ethics mean that you don't use software to deceive your audience or dramatized events in your entry. The entry should be journalistic and strive for truth, accuracy, fairness and context.

SPECIFICATIONS

Students may compete as an individual or as a team of no more than four students.

The video news entry must be uploaded to the KSPA online submission according to these specifications:

- Posted as an online link that is publicly accessible without password protection (for instance, YouTube or Vimeo). You will simply submit the URL for the entry.
- The entry should be no longer than 90 seconds in run time.
- The entry should not contain any copyright infringement through the use of audio or video
- The entry must be uploaded by visual category contest deadline.

Failure to follow these requirements may result in disqualification.

No need to pretend that you attend Sunflower High School, our fictional high school used for other categories. Simply create a video news package as you normally would.
