#### **About Light + Love Arts**

Light + Love Arts is a process-based art studio and education program rooted in **creativity, sensory exploration, nature connection, and child-led learning**. Our summer camps invite children to explore materials deeply, build confidence through play, and experience art as a joyful, meaningful part of their everyday lives.

#### **Role Overview**

The Summer Camp Lead Teacher is the **heart of the camp experience** — guiding children through open-ended art, exploration, and creative play while holding a warm, safe, and joyful container for each day. Lead Teachers design and facilitate daily art invitations, support mixed-age groups, and work closely with Assistant Teachers to ensure camp days flow smoothly and intentionally.

This role is ideal for someone who thrives in **hands-on, playful environments**, understands that meaningful learning happens through exploration, and loves creating memorable summer experiences for children.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

##### **Camp Leadership & Daily Flow**

- Lead daily camp programming, including arrival, art time, outdoor play, snack, and transitions
- Create a calm, predictable rhythm that helps children feel safe and supported
- Maintain group safety, engagement, and positive behavior using child-centered strategies
- Foster a joyful, inclusive camp culture rooted in kindness and creativity

### **Art & Experience Facilitation**

- Plan and facilitate **process-based art invitations** aligned with weekly camp themes
- Offer materials in ways that encourage experimentation, collaboration, and independence
- Integrate sensory play, nature-based materials, and open-ended exploration
- Support a wide range of ages, abilities, and learning styles

### **Child Support & Relationship Building**

- Build meaningful, respectful relationships with campers
- Support emotional regulation, peer relationships, and confidence-building
- Use curiosity-driven facilitation language rather than product-focused instruction

- Clearly communicate expectations, roles, and activity flow
- Model Light + Love Arts facilitation style and values
- Collaborate with camp staff and leadership to reflect and improve programming

- Monitor supplies and communicate needs to Camp Director
- Follow all safety protocols, policies, and site guidelines
- Communicate professionally with families and partner staff as needed

## Role Overview

The Summer Camp Assistant Teacher plays a key supporting role in creating a smooth, joyful, and well-held camp experience. Assistant Teachers help bring each day to life by supporting art invitations, engaging with children, and ensuring transitions, materials, and group flow run seamlessly.

This role is perfect for someone who loves working with children, enjoys being hands-on and playful, and wants to grow their skills in creative education within a supportive team environment.

## Key Responsibilities

### Daily Camp Support & Flow

- Support the Lead Teacher in the daily rhythm of camp (arrival, art time, outdoor play, snack, transitions, dismissal)
- Help maintain a calm, safe, and welcoming environment for all campers
- Assist with transitions to keep the day flowing smoothly and predictably
- Support group management using positive, child-centered approaches

### Art & Play Facilitation

- Assist in setting up and resetting process-based art invitations
- Engage with children during art experiences—encouraging exploration, creativity, and independence
- Support sensory play, outdoor exploration, and hands-on activities
- Help adapt materials and support children of varying ages and abilities

## **Child Support & Engagement**

- Build warm, respectful relationships with campers
