Should there ever be a support case, we need at least information about the plugin and shop version. Please note that we only provide free support if both are up to date and you have not made any changes yourself. If so, please also check whether the problem exists in the standard Shopware theme (is understandable), as incompatibilities can also arise through the graphical individualization of the shop. These cannot be tested in our test before publication and are therefore excluded from free support.

As a goodwill gesture, we will look after your problem if your plugin or shop version is not too old. However, this decision is entirely up to us when we act out of goodwill.

In our case, support doesn't just mean fixing errors, it also means helping. If something is unclear or incomprehensible, please feel free to write to us.

Tests

You can test all of our plugins for 30 days free of charge and in full. We even ask for it. Only then can you determine without a doubt that the plugin does exactly what you hoped for or expected. Our support will also support you during this test period under the conditions mentioned above.

The plug-in

With our article-listing-switch plug-in, you can offer your customers the option of determining the appearance of the category listing themselves. Your customer can decide for himself whether he wants to have large pictures or just facts displayed (a preselection is made by the shop operator). The plugin provides six different listings. Four of them are the standard listings from Shopware and two that we have created as examples. This leaves plenty of space for your ideas (knowledge of CSS required).

For those who are in a hurry to order, there is even an absolute quick orderer view in combination with our quick item purchase plugin, where your customer only has to enter the quantity and can put all the products together in the shopping cart. But be careful, in this case you have to actively use both plugins. Are you curious? Yes, we provide a test version for all of our plugins so that you can take your time to check whether our plugin meets your ideas and requirements.

listing1.tpl and listing2.tpl are additional views created by us as examples, which you can either further customize or use as we have stored them. Please note that these listings have to be updated so that they are not lost in the event of a plugin update.

If you have developed your own listing, enter the name of the listing here, separated by a comma.

All listings that are entered here are made available to your customer for selection. Therefore, you decide here which one you offer to choose from. It is not advisable to offer all of them.

Adaptation of the text modules

You can name these terms individually using the text modules. The names of the text modules begin with

- SwpListingSwitch_template _...
- or
- MofaListingSwitch_template _...

depending on whether the Swp or Mofa version is used.

further text modules that should be adapted when used in combination with:

- quick purchaseSwpQuickBuy.tpl (or MofaQuickBuy.tpl) - e.g. B.quick
- QuickBuyTitlepurchase view - e.g. B. Quick purchase

views

Standard(default)

- listingWith this selection, the listing is used which is stored in the categorycategory listingcategory listing

Detailed information (detail)

- corresponds to standard"Detailed information"

only important information (minimal)

- corresponds to standard"only important information"

Large picture (image)

- corresponds to standard"Large image"

Article box (emotion)

- corresponds to the presentation of the article box in a shopping world

list (list)list

- corresponds to standard"product"

categorycategorycentered (listing1.tpl)

- listinglistingexample listing as a list, everything centered, with image

without image (listing2. tpl)

- exemplary listing as a list, everything centered, without image

SwpQuickBuy (MofaQuickBuy)

- exemplary listing, which enables all products of the respective category to be shown with the most important information and to be placed in the shopping cart together. You do not have to buy each product separately to be able to. (only be used in combination with the "Item" plug-in)in combinations

Plugin combinations

In general, all combinations with third-party plug-cluding plug-from Shopware that are not with the Community Edition are untested. Therefore, no statement can be made about their interaction.

In combination with the "Quick Item Purchase" plug-in, items that use the following Module Factory plug-in were excluded:

- Price on request
- Age
- check Product options
- Free text input
- Variants

These products have to be placed in the shopping cart via the item details page. A quick purchase is not possible.

Individual badges are not displayed in the "quick purchase view".
