

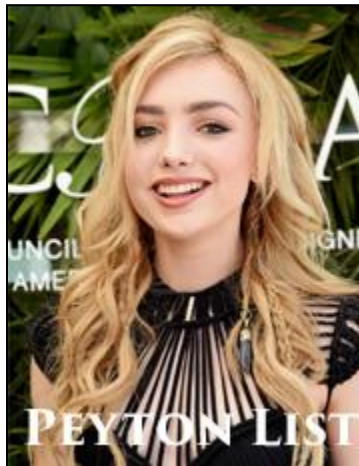
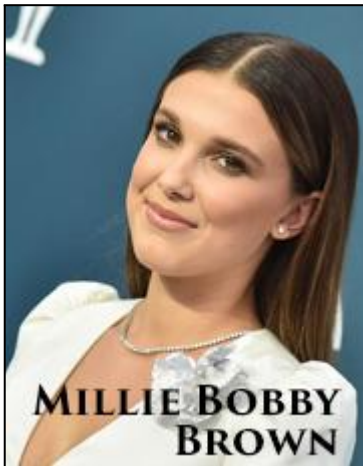
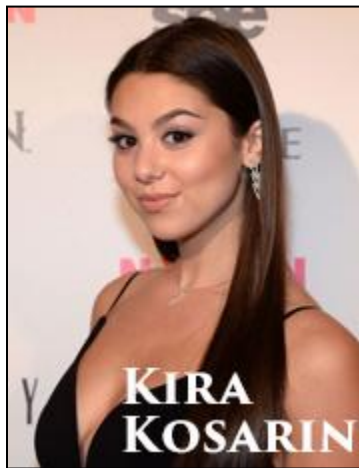
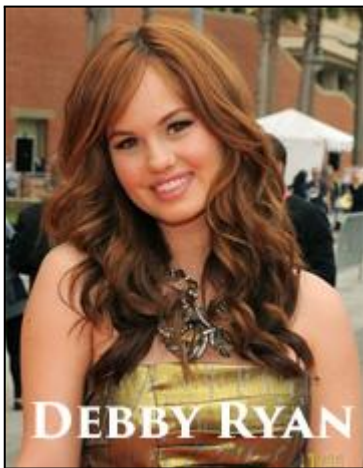
The Hellfire Starlet Sitcom: S01 E05

The following is a plot synopsis for Season 1, Episode 5.

Debby, however, is calm and composed as ever and remarks on how it's nice that they are doing something together.
