- ❖ We do not require membership fees, we wish to remain accessible to anyone that wishes to be a part of our group which means we ask for people to give in other ways.
- We do not have leaders, only active members that attend regularly and lend a hand in making our events and classes possible.
- Everyone volunteers. This is the foundation of our group! If you are a part of us you will be giving and receiving at each gathering. We use each parents skills, experience, talents, and resources.

#### I'M NEW TO THE GROUP....WHERE DO I START?

First things first, we want to meet you! We take every safety measure to screen each new member of our facebook group. We ask that new comers commit to attending 1 event in their first three months of joining the online facebook group.

We do not require attendance every week but do require participation monthly to ensure your membership. This not only helps us plan out activities appropriately but also ensures the safety and trust of all members.

After we have met you, you are welcome to volunteer and sign up on the events you are able to attend. We have lots of affordable and free events to choose from every week!

#### Volunteerism

As a member you will volunteer your time to organize and delegate duties involved in creating a class or event. Members are happy to volunteer and assist you as needed. We like to keep things affordable so that we can be as inclusive as possible. Our group is secular in nature which means our activities/field trips/lessons are without religious affiliation. We welcome the study of all topics within this secular approach.

BEFORE proceeding with creating events: please view our events tab in the CIH facebook group. We try to avoid having conflicting events so that everyone has an opportunity to attend. Another useful tool is the facebook post Poll option. You can poll the group by asking what time/date would be best and give out a few options. That has worked great for us especially with trips that require registration and a commitment.

Members/volunteers are responsible for:

~Brainstorming- Choose a theme, ask members for feedback if you like, create a relaxed agenda, most of our classes/clubs are 1-2 hours.

~Supplies- You can either ask everyone to bring their own supplies, or provide inexpensive supplies for everyone. Due to not being a registered non-profit organization we prefer to minimize exchanging money but have used paypal in the past as needed.

~Presentation- members have used powerpoint, youtube, etc. to throw together presentations, be as creative or simplistic as you like!

#### How to create an event for Cypress Inclusive Homeschoolers

- 1. Become a member- simply attend an event and meet everyone face to face, boom you're a member!
- 2. Join the members only group- after you attend an event and you decide you would like to volunteer let a member know so that we can add you to the secret facebook group where we plan events. Our planning group has many files with ideas to choose from.
- 3. <u>Poll</u><<<<< depending on your event/idea you may want to check and make sure members can attend the event. You can simply poll and ask everyone in the secret group what their availability is.
- 4. Create the event in the public facebook group. Anyone can do it! Just go to the events tab > +create event > then enter in the info > done!
