



Proposal for Union Partnership on “Labor for Prop 15” Virtual Phone Banks and Digital Events

Goal: Build coalitions among CA labor unions to support progressive political causes like Prop 15.

Proposal: Union partnership on virtual phone banks and political education events for Prop 15 to be organized and attended by union members up and down the state, supported by UAW Local 2865 and DSA's Yes on 15 campaign. UAW Local 2865 and DSA will bottomline logistics, help promote the events, provide voter calling lists as well as technology to reach out to voters, and assist in training phone bank captains from the participating unions. Participating unions will encourage turnout among their respective members.

More importantly, though, these phone banks are an opportunity to form coalitions among labor unions and build power to push the state on its budget priorities, which will be crucial as public sector employees gear up for the fight against austerity.
