WHY THIS MATTERS

Your House Representative is your most local federal voice. They represent your specific district and are directly accountable to you. Constituent letters are logged, tallied, and reported to the member.

House Democrats have procedural tools, floor time, and a public platform they are not using aggressively enough. This letter tells your rep that their constituents expect them to fight -- loudly and on the record.

Dear Representative [Last Name],

I am your constituent and I am writing because I need my representative to hear directly from me: the Democratic Party is not fighting hard enough, and I expect you to say so loudly.

This is not a slow-moving crisis -- it is happening right now. This week, the Virginia Supreme Court blocked a Democratic-leaning map. The U.S. Supreme Court gutted a core provision of the Voting Rights Act, clearing the path for Republicans to eliminate Democratic districts across the South. Cook Political Report now counts 10 more Republican-leaning House seats than Democratic ones, with Louisiana and Alabama redistricting still to come. The NRCC held a closed-door celebration boasting that Democrats spent \$70 million fighting for fair maps -- and



lost. Republicans are calling these rulings "seismic." They are right. The question is whether Democratic leadership will treat them that way.

Republicans have spent two decades building structural advantages through REDMAP, through court capture, through coordinated state legislative investment, and through voting restrictions engineered to suppress Democratic turnout. They did not do this by playing nice. They did it by playing to win.

You are in the House. You have a platform and a vote. Here is what I am asking you to do with it:

First, use every procedural tool available -- every motion, every demand for recorded votes, every public statement -- to force accountability on the record and slow the consolidation of power.

Second, advocate publicly and forcefully for Democratic investment in state legislatures before the 2030 redistricting cycle. The states where Democrats hold power must use it. Now.

Third, stop waiting for bipartisan cover that is not coming. Name what is happening. Vote accordingly. Say it out loud in this district.

I am your constituent. I am watching. I will remember.
