### Village Board Meeting

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#### Call to Order

President Farr called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in a hybrid model, in person and via video conference for remote participants, per the Governor's executive order on Covid 19 guidance.

President Farr mentioned that he and Trustee Tillman were working with the residents of 67 Overlook on possible modifications to their property.

## Police Report

Chief McEnerney had a personal event, and was not present. Chief McEnerney relayed that there was nothing to report, however, there have been several residential burglaries in neighboring communities and wanted to remind homeowners to lock doors and windows.

## Engineer's Report

Brian Wesolowski reported that the final payment for the bond work is on the MTR this month, closing out Chicagoland and Builder's Paving bills. The crack sealing work was completed last week, and the final pricing will be coming from both contractors (including the sidewalk replacement contractor). The village does not have any more capital projects this year.

### **Approval of Bills**

### **Public Buildings and Grounds Department**

Trustee Shine reported that there is a tree removal request at 50 Overlook Drive, and guidance will be given to the property owner.

### **Finance and Administration Department**

Trustee Miller communicated that our cash position is strong. There are 3 residents that have outstanding accounts, the board recommended that the Police Chief contact the homeowners to remind them of payment.

Trustee Der Avedisian moved to approve the audit report that was reviewed last month. Trustee Tillman seconded the motion.

Trustee Miller discussed the upcoming tax levy for the village, related to the debt and general funds. The board will target 1%-2% for our levy, and will also consider other sources of funding through the state, and other sources. Additionally, we will discuss tax abatement with respect to one bond issuance at the December board meeting.

### **Streets and Sanitation Department**

There was a sewer issue at 59 and 61 Overlook, and the board discussed the way the sewers served these residences. The residents will be billed back for their share of the work.

### **Utilities Department**

Glenview has decided to increase the water operator agreement from \$11K to \$25K per annum, the agreement will also be updated with roles and responsibilities. Clarification on specific issues have been made for the draft agreement, with water main repairs being a joint responsibility.

Trustee Tillman moved to approve a Resolution Approving the Water Operator Agreement with the Village of Glenview. Trustee Der Avedisian seconded the motion.
