- 6:45 Dashboard Review
  - 5 groups looked at 22-23 data at the state, county, and district level for 7 categories that are captured on the <u>CA Dashboard</u>.
  - Main Noticings and Wondering/Implications tied to Data dive based on the poster work completed during meeting:
    - What is the significance of the colors? How are the colors determined within the gas gauges?
      - Many groups had questions surrounding why certain groups had seemingly better rates/numbers but their overall gauge was lower.
        - Possible Answer: Performance levels are determined by both the status and change over time to give a more complete picture rather than a snapshot in the moment. So, while the percentages may indicate a different color the changes over time may be a the point of color
    - What is SFUSD currently doing to move students in the right direction? How can LCAP Advisory Committee members help that progress?
      - Some groups noticed the same groups over the years have repeatedly been in the higher performance level, so what has SFUSD been doing for the groups that continuously test in the lower performance levels?
    - How complete is the data presented?
      - A notice from groups was that CCR as a whole in SFUSD was High, but many of the schools had "No Performance Level" as their indicator as well as the only 2 schools indicated are "Very High" are selective enrolment (require and application).
      - Under the "Chronic Absenteeism" category were, "Poor air quality days:, "religious/cultural holidays",
