Elementary Enrichment courses run for eight weeks and are open to students who attend the school at which each course is offered.

Classes are designed and led by NPS staff or vendors partnered with NPS, and focus on hands-on exploration and collaborative fun!

Tuition:

\$125/course/child for 8-week session (1 course/week)

Before School Course Times:

Course selections differ and may not be offered at every school each session.

Note:

- Children may only be enrolled in one course per day. Select 1st, 2nd, or 3rd choices in case the first choice fills.
- Space is limited. If demand exceeds capacity, we use a lottery. On or before the registration deadline, registered families will receive an email with their enrollment status. Do not pay without receiving enrollment confirmation.
- No change request after registration ends.

GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

Enrollment

We will email by October 7 to let you know if: (a) your child has been enrolled, (b) your child is on our wait list, or (c) your selection[s] was under-enrolled and cancelled. Please DO NOT submit payment at this time. If you receive an email from us confirming enrollment, payment will be due October 18. Thank you!

Tuition

Payment should be made <u>online</u> at Elementary Enrichment Programs - #010101 after receiving course enrollment confirmation. If we do not receive it by the deadline, enrollment will be canceled.

PickUp Patrol

Please update your dismissal plan in PickUp Patrol for enrichment days.

ASAP

If your child attends the ASAP program on an enrichment day, the enrichment instructor will bring your child to ASAP after the end of each class.

If your child will be absent from an enrichment session

Make this dismissal change in PickUp Patrol and email your elementary enrichment instructor.

Make sure all appropriate adults are listed as alternate pick-ups

At the end of class, the instructor will escort children to the main entrance for pick-up. Only adults on the registration form may pick up. They must be 18 and older and carry photo ID. Email the instructor to add additional adults to your pick-up list.

Children must be picked up by an authorized adult, they may not walk home.

Allergies/Medical Conditions

Your child's enrichment instructor will receive the information you provided about your child's allergies or other medical concerns, and will follow up with the school nurse in preparation for keeping all children healthy and safe during Elementary Enrichment.

Children should bring a **nut-free snack and a water bottle**. See the course descriptions for any additional materials needed.
