GOOGLE CLASSROOM

This is the platform students will use to complete any assignments scheduled for the class. There are two tabs at the top that I would like to bring to your attention. The **STREAM** tab is where students will see the assignments and announcements I will be posting for the class. The posts in this section will be organized from most recent at the top to the earliest at the bottom. It is important students check this tab especially for announcements. The other one is the **CLASSWORK** tab. I highly suggest students to use this tab to access the assignments they will be required to work on during this time. I divided this section by topics (NTI Week#1, #2, etc.), in other words, it is divided by week. **Each week, students will complete the work that is listed under that topic by 9:00 p.m on Friday of that week.**

ATTENDANCE

This is going to be very interesting. We are still required to record attendance as we would normally do on a regular school day. In my class, I will be recording attendance by the completion of assignments. Among the assignments listed for each week, there is one activity titled ATTENDANCE. Students will be required to complete ALL tasks in each NTI Week topic in order to be counted present for the week. If students fail to comply with this, I will be communicating with parents/guardians and school administration.

GOOGLE MEET

There is nothing like being in the classroom helping students with questions and concerns that they may have, yet, we can't do that. Nevertheless, I would like to be accessible to my students as much as possible. Therefore, I will be using, along with other modes of communications (phone, emails, etc.), this tool provided to us that many other teachers nationwide are also using. Google Meet is an application that allows people to communicate like Facetime. I will be holding virtual office hours on Mondays and Wednesdays from 2 - 4 p.m. EST. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions about materials or assignments they may be struggling with. I will post every week the link that students can use to join me live for questions.

EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT IN OUR NTI VIRTUAL CLASS
