






Rent Satisfaction

How satisfied are you with the rent that you are currently paying?

Reports of satisfaction varies from building to building:


In response to the question "How satisfied are you with the rent you are currently paying?", no one living in Old Hall, the oldest building in dire need of repairs, answered that they were satisfied, while 80% of respondents argued that they were dissatisfied.

The results for Dorothy Garrod, the swanky £27M million new building, do not paint a pretty picture either, with only 12.5% of respondents saying they were satisfied with rent, and 74.8% saying they were dissatisfied.

Value for money

Do you feel that the accommodation quality matches the price?

99 responses




1- doesn't match, 5 - matches completely Again, this varies according to building.

In response to the question "Do you feel that the accommodation quality matches the price?", only 5% of residents of Old Hall, and 8.3% of residents of Dorothy Garrod agreed that the accommodation quality did match the price. However, while 85% of residents of Old Hall said they were not satisfied, this number was only 25% of students for Dorothy Garrod, with more students (41%) opting to vote that they had no strong feelings either way.

100 responses




1 - doesn't affect at all, 5 - affects a lot


36% of students said that the cost of rent significantly affects their ability to enjoy being at university, while only 12% said it didn't affect at all.

The testimonies cannot be shared, but students cited reasons such as mental health, the guilt of a financial burden on parents, and the opportunity costs of high rent meaning that they had to stop doing extra-curriculars they used to enjoy.

Here is the data for Dorothy Garrod Building specifically:

The % increased to 46% of people feeling that the cost of rent affected their ability to enjoy being at university.






Effectiveness of bursaries


