

Sportsmanship Award 2025

SEGL awards \$400 for the Sportsmanship Award. To encourage the development of good sportsmanship, strong character, and leadership, as a role model to fellow skaters. SEGL awards a monetary scholarship to the council member best exhibiting the following qualities: leadership, industriousness, concern for others, spirit, sportsmanship, academic performance, perseverance, and coachability. The selected candidate will be notified before the SEGL Competition and announced at the SEGL Annual Meeting. The Awards presentation will take place at the SEGL Competition, or whenever is convenient for the skater and SEGL committee.

Application Procedure

1. Applicant must be a current registered USFS member of a SEGL member club in good standing
2. Applicant is not required to have competed in the SEGL Invitational Competition. However, previous participation may weigh heavily in the selection process
3. A club representative must submit an individual letter describing the candidate and how they demonstrate the qualities stated above
4. Include a letter of recommendation from the skater's coach
5. The skater is to submit an essay on what skating means to him/her
6. Completed questionnaire, signed by parent or guardian
7. All applications for 2025 must be submitted by December 31, 2025
