Keys to Effective Peer Visits

- Good Listening: patient, equally listen & talk, create space for the other person to think & share
- **Growth Mindset**: open to change, eager to give and receive feedback, willing to appreciate new perspectives & alternative ways of acting and thinking
- Curious Learner: genuine curiosity, willing to engage, feel comfortable to share information & learn from each other
- Self-Aware: flexible to accept other best alternatives, recognize their strengths and weaknesses, gladly accept feedback even if it's negative
- Respectful: conversations remain private and non-judgemental, supportive statements, use of open-ended questions
