



Marysville High School Schedule Change Request Form 2026-2027

Schedule changes can be made for the following reasons:

1. Semester imbalances
2. Replacement of summer school course(s) successfully completed
3. Schedule adjustments for Credit Flexibility options approved by the administration
4. Appropriate educational adjustments for students on an IEP
5. Inappropriate course level as dictated by the prerequisite
6. Level change (If a level change is completed, the grades from the original class will follow the new course and be averaged at the end of the term.)

ADDING COURSES

Year-long and 1st semester classes can be added within the first **5** days of the 1st semester. Students can add 2nd semester classes within the first **5** days of 2nd semester.

DROPPING MHS COURSES

Year-Long Courses	Semester Courses (1 st & 2 nd)
No penalty if dropped within first 5 days of 1 st semester.	1 st semester & 2 nd semester-No penalty if dropped within first 5 days of corresponding semester.
If dropped by last day of the 1 st 9 weeks a “WD” (withdrawn) will be added to transcript.	1 st semester course- If dropped by interim of 1 st 9 weeks- 2 nd semester course-If dropped by interim of 3 rd 9 weeks- a “WD” (withdrawn) will be added to transcript.
If dropped after 1 st 9 weeks a “WF” (withdrawn failing) will be added to transcript (averages in GPA as an “F”).	1 st semester course- If dropped after 1 st 9 weeks interim- 2 nd semester course-If dropped after 3 rd 9 weeks interim- a “WF” (withdrawn failing) will be added to transcript.

DROPPING COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS COURSES

Students who drop a course after the college’s deadline may be charged the cost of tuition by Marysville High School.
