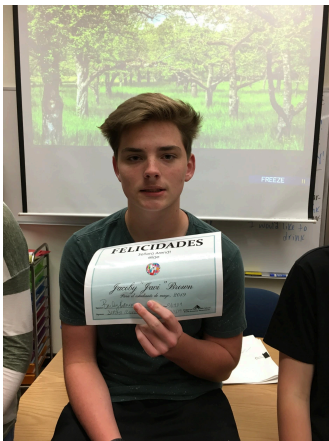




## **World Language Students of the Month MAY**
